**OVERNIGHT SHOOTING/ARMED ASSAULT WITH INTENT TO MURDER**

The Lowell Police Department responded to a reported shooting incident at 12:46am this morning in front of 370 Merrimack St. Upon arriving they found a 19 year old male subject suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a local hospital then Med Flighted to Beth Israel Deaconess in Boston. He is expected to survive his injuries. Three .22 caliber shell casings were found at the scene. Information received indicates the shooting was the result of an altercation the victim had with at least three other individuals.
